





### Contra Costa Intergroup - August 26, 2025

Chair (Matt W) opened the meeting at 7:30 with Serenity Prayer Secretary (Ashley J) Read meeting minutes.

Group Overview: Darryl I. (Life is Sobriety, Monday 5:30 Wiget) - Life is Sobriety is a speaker/open discussion meeting at St. Matthew Lutheren Church on Wiget Ln in Walnut Creek. It was registered with GSO in 1985. The meeting started off at St. Matthew in the church library. During a remodel from 2009-2011, the meeting moved to Walnut Ave United Methodist Church in Walnut Creek. Once remodeling at St. Matthew was complete the group moved back. They moved into a larger meeting space to accommodate a large influx of new members. Life is Sobriety has many service positions including GSR, Intergroup and alternates, and holds business meetings monthly. The group established a grapevine lending library in 2014. In 2018/2019 the group began having potlucks to celebrate holidays and in the summer season, BBQ's and pool parties. In person meetings were suspended during Covid, and the group met via Zoom until in-person meetings opened again. Attendance ranges between 50 and 80 people. Roughly 75% attend on a weekly basis. Life is Sobriety has a particularly strong sense of comradery. Many members arrive early and stay late, socializing and enhancing each other's sobriety.

**Topic Presentation:** How to Conduct a Group Inventory (Carol H, Group Facilitator)

A group inventory is important to do once a year to once every other year. Pamphlet "The A.A. Group-Where it all begins" Pg 29 contains info on group inventory. It lists 13 suggested questions. When a group decides to do an inventory, they may want to take a mix of the suggested questions, and some that the group comes up with. It is also wise to have a group facilitator assist with the inventory. The facilitator has no investment in the group. They often bring a scribe as well, which allows all members the opportunity to share. The inventory really is a whole group discussion. Cross talk is not advised, as the purpose is to share what works well and what doesn't work well, not to argue. After the inventory, the scribe will send the comments to the group, and the group will meet again to go over the comments and decide how to proceed in areas that need improvement.

#### Remarks:

- When inventory is done, it should be done at a separate time. Not during the meeting. May take a few sessions.
- Does a group need to have one facilitator and one scribe? Yes, it works better.
- Where does a group find the facilitator/scribe? Anyone can be a facilitator, but it is important to find someone who has participated in an inventory before. Suggested to call someone who is in General Service.
- Does the scribe write verbatim? The scribe should note every comment.

- What are "symptoms" that may require a group inventory? It is better to do an inventory often so
  "symptoms" don't arise, but if something comes up at a meeting that may warrant comments at a
  business meeting then a group inventory is probably a great idea.
- Does the facilitator have to be DCM? No. Is it better for a facilitator to have been a scribe before as well? Not necessarily, no credentials required.
- Once a group has determined what the "issues" are how is it determined what the outcome on those
  issues are? The people who have participated in the inventory should make the group conscious.

September presentation suggestions: Financial report knowledge: How to read.
