





Secretary (Ashley J) Read meeting minutes. Accepted as read.

Treasurer (Steve B) Revenue: \$9,210; Expenses \$8,977 for NOI of \$233 Cash Balance \$39,158 as of August 31, 2025.

- Why is the rent income so much lower than the budget? Many groups pay quarterly rather than monthly so it evens out yearly.
- Accepted as read.

Group Overview: Rescheduled EBYPAA

- October- Ally (Give it Away Group)

Topic Presentation: Steve B- Financial Reports: How to read & Interpret

Revenue is money coming in, and expenses are money going out. YTD: Year to Date. FY: Full Year.

- Book Sales 25% net": 75% is the actual cost of the books, and 25% is the amount intergroup makes on the sales.
- Bucks club/member donations vs group contributions: Bucks/member are straight donations, and group contributions are sent in from groups 7th tradition.
- Mayhew meeting room rent: \$100/mo. Archives rent: \$525/mo.
- All Groups Revenue- Is that just 7th tradition? It is <u>all</u> revenue from meeting (Raffle, 7th, etc).
- Rent for 185 and 193 are separated on the report.
- Expenses/Revenue may not all be reported for the current month, especially with events. There may seem to be discrepancies but will even out once all is reported.
- Summary: Breaks down revenue/expenses clearly.
- Cash book receipts Breaks down the 75/25% mentioned earlier.
- Total Liquid Assets: Wells Fargo, Prudent Reserves (Operations reserve and relocation reserve). It has been determined through research that relocation reserve will not be enough for actual relocation.
- Special Events: Money is taken from operations reserve to "pre-pay" for venue, supplies, etc. Revenue will then replace it.
- Savings Account (fee free accts): \$500+ to be kept in account to allow other accounts to be fee free.
- Book fund acct: Money kept strictly for books
- Book inventory on hand: Current total of books available for sale.
