Chair (Matt W) opened the meeting at 7:30 with Serenity Prayer

Secretary (Ashley J) Read September meeting minutes. Accepted as read.

Treasurer (Steve B) Revenue: \$13,795; Expenses \$12,110 for NOI of \$18,334 Cash Balance \$43,062 as of September 30, 2025.

New Intergroup Reps: Paul (No matter What), Beth (Wise Women), Evan (Love and Service)

Group Overview: Ally – Give It Away Group: Tuesday 8pm @ 1635 Challenge Dr. Apx. 20-30 attendees, with a good mix of newcomers and long-term sobriety. First meeting was 11/8/2022.

November: Ann (Girls Gone Mild), January: James (Crockett Group)

Topic Presentation:

Matt- Currently, no timeline for hiring of special worker. Bylaws state that Operating Committee "manage" the Special Worker. IOC is pulling together updated job description. AdHoc committee has been formed with current and former chairpersons, service center chair and treasurer. They will be doing the interviews, etc. and the IOC will have the final decision making. We are unable to get into the special worker laptop, so some things will not be printed this month. A new laptop will be purchased with a budget of \$1500-\$2000. This is vital to the service center.

Alice- Physical office has been cleaned and organized. Office will need to be renovated/repared to prepare for new special worker.

Open Forum-

- John: What finances do we have access to? A: Wells Fargo only. Not PayPal and Fidelity. Waiting on death certificate.
- Greg: Is it reasonable to get more authorized people on each account? A: Yes. We have a plan to add current IG Chair and Secretary to accounts moving forward.
- Don: A few groups have asked about umbrella insurance for groups. What is the progress? A: Steve is working on the insurance, and will be paid ASAP.
- John: Will groups be uncovered for a period of time? A: Steve is working on it as quickly as possible.
- James: Suggested cloud storage and password manager for new laptop.
- Will there be a memorial service? A: That is the plan, and information forthcoming.
- Alice: Office is fully operational. Temporarily, credit cards cannot be used.
- Steve: Website has been paid for and is current. Steve will be reimbursed.
- How will we list special worker job? A: We will have a time window for applications and will inform all how to apply.
- Job description has been finalized and approved by IOC.
- Evan: Does the special worker have to be an alcoholic? A: Bylaws state it must be someone who has 5 years of continuous sobriety.
- Can anyone go to Operation Committee meeting? A: No, it is only for IOC members.
- Don: Would it be helpful to if groups delayed contributions? A: No. Please keep contributing.
- Jennifer: Will benefits continue to be given to new special worker? A: Yes, the compensation package would stay the same, or very similar.
- Is the position full-time? A: Yes. Will be listed in job description.
- Office renovations/repairs- Will landlord be involved? A: Landlord may do some, but as tenants we would be responsible for the rest.
- Don: Maintenance stated that repairs/renovations are our responsibility.

Old Business:
