**Group Overview:** Ann Girls gone Mild: Mondays 7 pm @ 2000 San Pablo Ave in Pinole. Women's Big Book Study. The first meeting was held on August 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Earlier that year the Ladies Tea group had a group inventory and highlighted the need for a women's book study in the El Sobrante area. The founding members, including Tina O., trialed the new meeting and covered service positions until the meeting grew. At the first business meeting, they discussed the name of the meeting. Tina had dreamed of naming a meeting "Girls Gone Mild" since her first year in sobriety. "Girls Gone Mild" was only 6 months old when the covid shutdown began. The meeting went online quickly. The first in person meeting after shutdown happened to be almost exactly on the meetings first anniversary. "Girls Gone Mild" studies the big book, and at each meeting several members read a few paragraphs at a time then opens for discussion. The meeting is open and encourages cross talk in the spirit of learning more about the program.

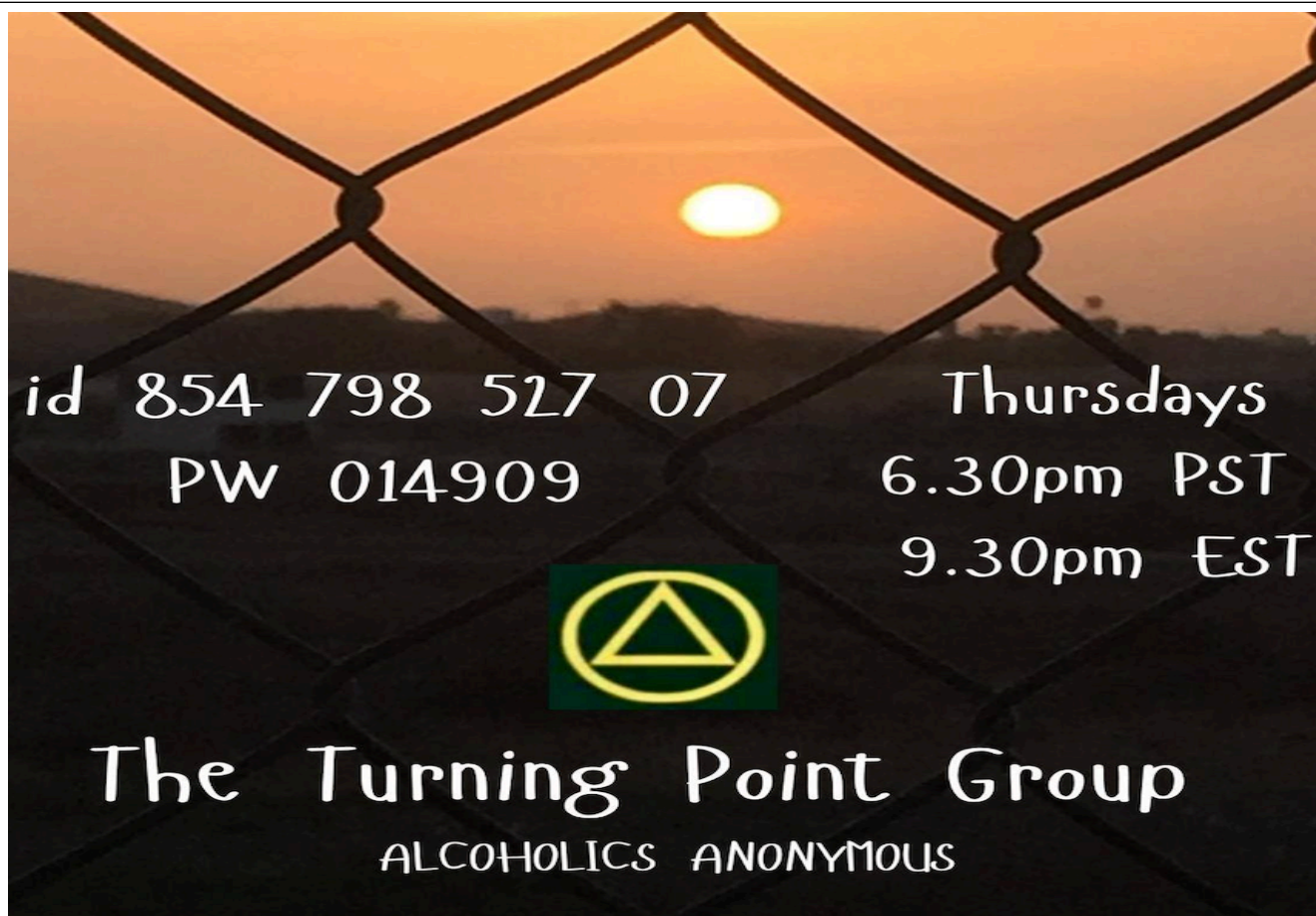
