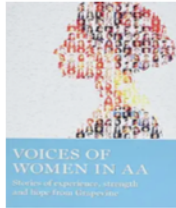

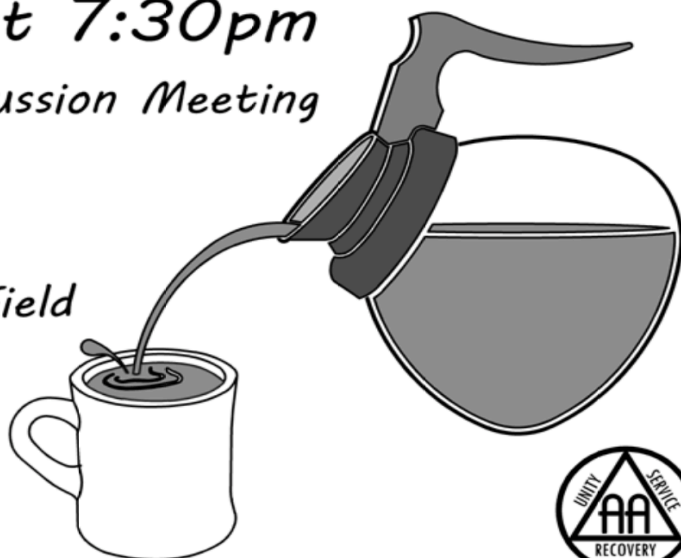

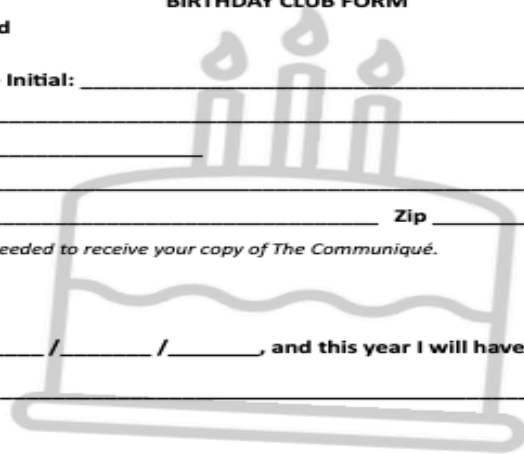

February 24, 2026**

Chair (Alice S) opened the meeting at 7:30 with Serenity Prayer

- Roll- All committee chairs are in attendance with exception of Telephone Hotline (Jorge Z) and Public Information (Craig F)
- 49 Intergroup Reps in attendance. 2/3 majority is 33

New Intergroup Reps: Velma – Forgiven and Free, Max -Putnam Nooners, Jeff- Monday Men's Unscripted, Mike – 4th Dimension

Secretary (Ashley J) Read meeting minutes. Approved as corrected:

- Treasurer report as of November 30, 2025, not May 31, 2025

Treasurer (Steve B) Revenue: \$46,044; Expenses \$37,156 for NOI of (\$8,889) Cash Bala if January 31, 2026.

- Treasures report has been re-organized to make it cleaner and to put expenses/revenue in categories that make more sense. Location expenses have been broken down by each building (185/193)
- Doug: If someone pays with a credit card online, do we add on a fee to counter the fees charged to us?
 - Not currently, other than ticket sales. We are revisiting the policy to potentially add an additional fee to card transactions.
- Will prudent reserve be raised to match more current moving expenses?
 - Not at this time, may be discussed by IOC.
- Motion to approve, seconded and approved.

Group Overview: Primary Purpose Group (Marcus):

The Primary Purpose group meets Thursdays at 7 at the East Contra Costa Fellowship Hall. It is a Big Book Study. The group is registered with General Service. The PPG held its first meeting on April 7th 2022 at the ECCFH. During Covid, Michael H. discovered an interesting format being used by a meeting in Texas. Once in person meetings resumed, he was compelled to start a new meeting with that format. The format uses a page by page format to study the literature, followed by discussion. Attendance began with 3-5 members, and is currently around 15-20 members. Members can scan a QR code that leads them to an abundance of information such as phone lists, email lists, bylaws, service descriptions, etc.

Topic Presentation:

- Lauren: Suggested discussion regarding how to carry information back to groups from Intergroup Meeting. Will be presented in May by Lauren P.

Old Business:

- Steve B. contract extension: The Intergroup Operating Committee approved an extension of Steve B's contract. This allowed the financial operation of the service center to be finalized. Steve will be paid \$600/wk for 2 weeks ending February 28, 2026.
- Communique mailing policy: Current Intergroup reps and alternates can request a communique be mailed for the duration of term. Once their term is over, the next representative will start receiving it. Communiques will be available for pick up at the service center. If a member outside of Intergroup would like a communique mailed to them, there are 2 options: They can sign up for the Bucks o Month club and will be mailed the communique for one year. Or they can sign up for the birthday club, which gets them the communique for their birthday month.

New Business:

- Financial and administrative authority:
 - Motion made to authorize Cynthia Stout as the duly hired and ratified manager of the Service Center, to serve as an authorized agent of the service center with full authority to act in matters involving fiduciary responsibility, financial oversight, and administrative operations necessary to maintain operational integrity. Such authority shall include, but not be limited to:
 - Serving as an authorized signer on all Service Center bank accounts
 - Opening and closing bank accounts as directed by the governing body
 - Depositing and withdrawing funds on behalf of the Service Center
 - Endorsing checks and other negotiable instruments
 - Accessing, administering and managing online banking services
 - Overseeing financial reporting and ensuring regulatory and policy compliance
 - Motion seconded. Formal vote conducted. 49 in favor. Unanimous vote.
 - Motion made to authorize Steve Burgess, in his capacity as duly elected Treasurer, to serve as an authorized agent of the Service Center with full authority to act in all matters relating to fiscal management and fiduciary compliance. Such authority shall include, but not be limited to:
 - Serving as an authorized signer on all Service Center bank accounts

- Opening and closing bank accounts as directed by the governing body
- Depositing and withdrawing funds on behalf of the Service Center
- Endorsing checks and other negotiable instruments
- Accessing, administering and managing online banking services
- Overseeing financial reporting and ensuring regulatory and policy compliance
 - Motion seconded. Formal vote conducted. 49 in favor. Unanimous vote.
- Q: When checks are written, how many signatures are required? Typically, only one signature is necessary, but if another is required, Treasurer would be second signature.
- IOC recommendation: Make All Groups Chair a member of Operating Committee. Term is a 2 year maximum.
 - Q: Will extra chair change the quorum for voting in the Operating Committee?
 - A: Not necessarily, depends on how many officers are in attendance and if it is a topic that can include special workers vote.
 - All Groups Speaker Meeting Chair is not technically an IOC Chair, because the meeting used to be considered special events. Adding the All Groups Chair would allow for support of the IOC to the All Groups Chair. All chairpersons have been voted on my Intergroup. All Groups Chair was never voted in since it was considered special events, but is no longer.
 - Motion made to consider All Groups Chair as a member of the Intergroup Operating Committee. Formal Vote conducted. 49 in favor, unanimous vote.
