The necessity of maintaining sufficient revenue to cover operational expenses was emphasized.

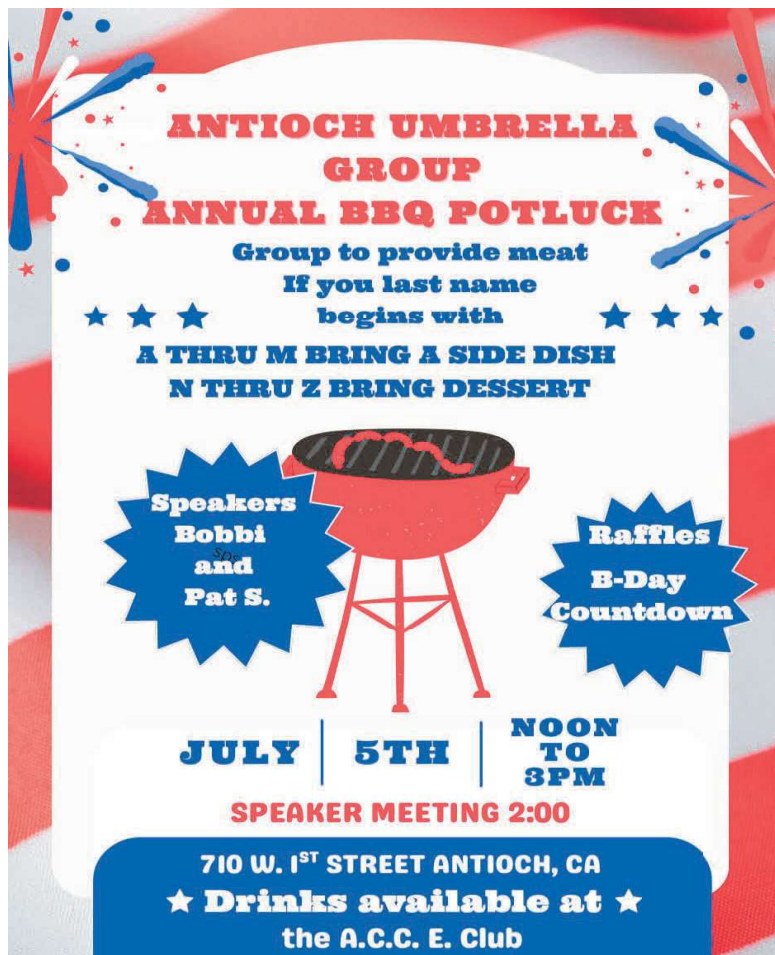
