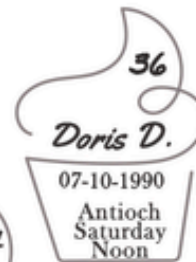

Meeting Information:

- Saturdays, 8:15 AM – 9:30 AM at St. Timothy's Episcopal Church, Danville (Closed Meeting)
- Founded January 7, 1987
- Originally known as the Mustard Seed Group meeting at the San Ramon Energy Center on Porter
- Later renamed the Principles Group
- Began studying the Traditions in October 1987 despite fear of losing members. Attendance doubled.
- Group currently alternates study between the Big Book and Twelve and Twelve

TOPIC PRESENTATION – Bylaws – Presented by Cyn S.

Overview. Cyn S. presented an overview of Intergroup bylaws, explaining that they serve as the organization's guiding principles, ensuring consistency, fairness, continuity, accountability, and alignment with Intergroup's mission of supporting AA groups in carrying the message. Intergroup was described as a practical coordination hub that provides services such as the hotline, literature distribution, events, and workshops. The original charter was adopted in 1966 and revised into the Bylaws in 1968.

Purpose and Importance. The presentation emphasized that bylaws provide structure without creating a governing authority, define voting procedures, financial transparency, election processes, and reinforce the principle of trusted servants rather than positions of power.

Review and Updates. Cyn noted that bylaws should be reviewed periodically (every 2–5 years) to ensure they remain relevant, reflect current practices, and comply with California nonprofit laws. Historical records indicate amendments were discussed and approved between 1997 and 1998, but it is unclear when the last comprehensive review occurred. The presentation was intended to start a conversation about whether a bylaw review is needed.

Discussion Highlights

- Members discussed access to the current bylaws, which are available in the Intergroup Handbook and will also be posted on the website.
- Questions were raised regarding how bylaws were originally adopted and how amendments can be made. Cyn clarified that any member may propose amendments, and section-by-section updates are both permissible and recommended.
- Several members suggested forming an ad hoc committee to review the bylaws. Cyn recommended postponing any motion until the next business meeting to allow IG REPS/ALTS time to review the bylaws with their groups and gather group conscience.
- Bylaw XVI was referenced, outlining amendment requirements, including a two-thirds vote, quorum requirements, and 60-day advance notice to groups.
- Members discussed whether the Intergroup Operating Committee (IOC) should initiate proposed changes. It was noted that while this may have occurred historically, the recommended practice is for IG REPS/ALTS propose changes to an Ad hoc committee that can do a deeper dive.

Action Recorded. The body agreed to place Bylaws Review under New Business for the June Intergroup Business Meeting to allow representatives time to review bylaws with their groups and gather group conscience prior to considering formation of an ad hoc review committee.

Public Information Chairperson Vacancy

- Chair Alice S. opened nominations for the vacant Public Information Chair position.
- Craig F. provided an overview of the position's responsibilities, including:
 - Community outreach activities (participation in community events and resource fairs)
 - Literature distribution
 - Relationship-building with community organizations

- Two nomination calls were conducted. No candidates stood for election. Position remains vacant.
- REPS/ALTS encouraged to discuss the position within home groups and return with interested parties.
- Position requirements: One-year term & suggested minimum two years sobriety

NEW BUSINESS

Updated Service Center Bookstore Price List (Cyn S.)

Cyn S. reported that AA World Services (AAWS) increased literature pricing in February and that the Contra Costa Service Center (CCSC) bookstore price list has been updated accordingly. The revised pricing aligns CCSC with AAWS and other Central Offices/Intergroups. Representatives were asked to share the updated price list with their groups.

Discussion Highlights

- Members asked when groups had been notified of the changes. It was noted that the issue had been discussed in February/March, just after AAWS increased their prices on Feb. 1.
- Cyn explained that charging for pamphlets was based on financial sustainability concerns and existing policy, except now all groups were being charged instead of only some. Aligning prices with AAWS was described as an important revenue source for the Service Center.
- Current practice allows office volunteers to use discretion and not charge individuals seeking help.
- CCSC pricing is now in line with other Central Offices / Intergroups
- Discussion included the relationship between literature costs, group contributions, and the Seventh Tradition. Several members noted that many groups absorb the cost of pamphlets to provide them free to newcomers.
- Member stated prior practice was for groups to give 70% in Contributions to SC to get free pamphlets.
- Member raised concerns from a recent business meeting. Discussed in the context of the 7th Tradition (groups should be fully self-supporting). The group would buy their pamphlets and "eat the cost" so they can provide pamphlets for free at their meeting, ensuring they're fully self-supporting.
- Questions were asked about the financial impact of pamphlet sales. Cyn noted that current financial tracking combines pamphlet and book sales, but future QuickBooks implementation will provide separate reporting for greater transparency.
